

(see evaluator credentials) 4. Evaluator should possess technical knowledge/skills related to evaluation, have equivalent certifications/experiences, completed self study, or have applicable academic credentials. 5. Upon completion of each activity the evaluator should sign and date in the box next to the skill assessed. 6. Student should maintain the performance evaluation with their certification.
